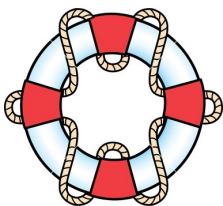

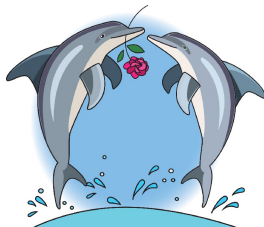

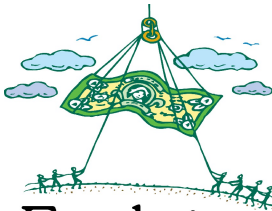
After a short business meeting, we will make crosses out of clothespins. It can be done and they are beautiful!

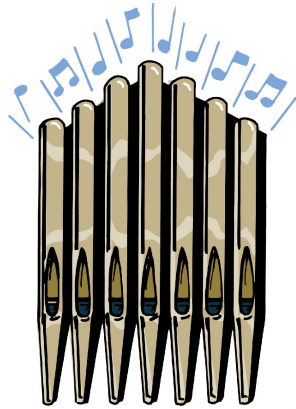
